I. STOP SIGN REQUEST

Last fall, the City received a request and petition from residents who live in the Grandshire subdivision requesting 3-way stops be installed at the intersections of Presidential Parkway and Grandshire Drive and Presidential Parkway and Salisbury Drive. The City Council recommended this request be deferred until officials from the Olentangy Schools provide the City a recommendation regarding suggested traffic control devices in the vicinity of the new Tyler Run Elementary School.

On July 24th, Staff met with representatives of the Olentangy School District. The Schools recommended the following suggestions:

- 1) Crosswalk be striped at the intersection of Salisbury Drive and Stamford Drive. Install pedestrian crossing sign.
- 2) Crosswalk be striped at the intersection of Salisbury Drive and Tiller Drive. Install pedestrian crossing sign.
- 3) School Zone be posted on Salisbury Drive near the school.
- 4) Install school speed limit sign on Salisbury Drive.

Staff is prepared to implement these recommendations prior to the start of the school year. It should be noted the City's corporate limits end just south of the school. Liberty Township and/or Delaware County is responsible for the portion of Salisbury Drive which is outside the City's limits.

As a result of receiving the Schools' recommendations, the Development Committee will now consider the request to install 3-way stops at Presidential and Grandshire and Presidential and Salisbury.
