

SERVICE COMMITTEE  
Meeting Minutes  
April 12, 2001

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 a.m. Committee Members present were Art Schultz and Bill Nolan. Also present were Steve Lutz and Lt. Hrytzick.

I. POWELL SAFETY CAMP

Lt. Hrytzick distributed a proposal regarding sponsoring a Safety Camp this summer. He stated that the 4-day camp would address issues such as Home Alone, 9-1-1, the Powell Police, and Fire Safety. One camp, which would be designed for grades Kindergarten - 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade, would be held from August 13<sup>th</sup> through the 16<sup>th</sup> from 10 a.m. to noon. The second camp, which would be designed for Grades 3 through 5, would be held August 20<sup>th</sup> through 23<sup>rd</sup> from 10 a.m. to noon.

The Lieutenant pointed out that these Safety Camps would be very beneficial in educating youngsters and would not put a tremendous strain on the resources and manpower of the Police Department. The Committee concurred that the proposed Safety Camp would provide a beneficial service to the community and could be handled without significantly impacting the Police Department.

The Lieutenant briefly discussed various issues with the Committee. He mentioned that beginning next week the Police Department would be fully staffed. He also discussed some of the principles and practices of community oriented policing.

II. ADJOURNMENT

Having no further business to come before the Committee, the meeting was adjourned at 8:00 a.m. The Committee stated that at their next meeting they would like to review and discuss job descriptions of each department and begin discussing whether it would be beneficial for the Village to distribute a comprehensive survey to its residents.
