AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE CONTRACT FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT 30 HALL STREET AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that real estate located at 30 Depot Street is necessary for municipal purposes, and,

WHEREAS, such premises is currently listed for sale and it may be advantageous for the municipality to acquire such premises at this time.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into a purchase contract for property located at 30 Hall Street in an amount not to exceed \$65,000.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
