**AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A THREE-WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL PARKWAY AND GRANDSHIRE DRIVE AND REQUIRING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PLACE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTION.**

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Municipality of Powell to create a three-way stop at the intersection of Presidential Parkway and Grandshire Drive, and

WHEREAS, Council has the authority to direct placement and maintenance of local traffic control devices.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the intersection of Presidential Parkway and Grandshire Drive be designated as a three-way stop intersection.

Section 2: That the City Engineer shall have appropriate traffic control devices placed at the subject intersection on the effective date of this Ordinance.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
