YEAR

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO PURCHASE CONTRACTS TO ACQUIRE PROPERTIES FOR RIGHT OF WAY PURPOSES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the purchase of real estate is necessary for right of way purposes, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to pass this ordinance as an emergency due to the immediate need to purchase the property for right of way purposes and in accordance with the provisions of Ordinance 2001-65.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The City Manager is authorized to enter into purchase contracts for property for right of way purposes in the amount not to exceed \$250,000.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
