## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 1337.02 OF THE BUILDING CODE OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, ENTITLED "CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS".

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is desirable to amend a section of the Building Code of the Municipality of Powell for the purpose of restricting construction operations on Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup>, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas, and New Years Day as set forth on the attachment hereto, and

### NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the attached Building Code amendments are hereby added to the Codified Ordinances of the Municipality of Powell as set forth on the attachment hereto which is incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

CHAPTER 1337  
Construction Requirements

**1337.02 CONSTRUCTION OPERATIONS**

- (a) It shall be unlawful to conduct construction operations between 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. Monday through Friday, 9:00 p.m. and 8:00 a.m. Saturday and 9:00 p.m. and 12:00 noon Sunday, Memorial Day, July 4<sup>th</sup> and Labor Day, or at any time on Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Years Day except by written conditional permit issued by the Building Commissioner.
