**A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A MUNICIPAL TRAFFIC CALMING POLICY FOR POWELL**

**WHEREAS**, Council has determined that it is beneficial to establish a policy which provides residents with a consistent procedure for the request, evaluation, and implementation of traffic calming measures for their neighborhoods.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The Council of the Municipality of Powell hereby adopts The Powell Traffic Calming Policy which is designed to provide a process through which residents can request traffic calming measures within neighborhoods.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.
