A RESOLUTION WAIVING OR REDUCING CERTAIN ZONING, RECREATION, AND BUILDING FEES RELATED TO THE CONSTRUCTION OF OLENTANGY LOCAL SCHOOL DISTRICT'S TYLER RUN ELEMENTARY AND LIBERTY MIDDLE SCHOOL.

Whereas, the Olentangy Local School District is finalizing construction of the Tyler Run Elementary School and the Liberty Middle School, and

Whereas, the Tyler Run Elementary School, which is located within the corporate limits of the municipality is subject to certain zoning, recreation, and building fees according to the municipal fee schedule, and

Whereas, the Liberty Middle School, which is located in Liberty Township, is subject to certain building fees according to the Municipal fee schedule, and

Whereas, Council has the authority to alter or waive such fees.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the \$910.00 Zoning Fee and \$28,500 recreation fee for the Tyler Run Elementary School be waived.

Section 2: In place of paying the City's Building Department Plan Review fee of \$5,148.18 per the Municipal fee schedule, the Olentangy Local School District will be charged the city's actual out of pocket costs associated with contracting plan review services for the Tyler Run Elementary School.

Section 3: In place of paying the City's Building Department Plan Review fee of \$8,770.89 per the Municipal fee schedule, the Olentangy Local School District will be charged the city's actual out of pocket costs associated with contracting plan review services for the Liberty Middle School

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
