Ordinance No. 2002-22 Passed May 21, YEAR 2002

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING COMPLETION OF THE SCIOTO RIDGE PATHWAY IMPROVEMENT CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT, FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SOLICIT BIDS, ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BIDS FOR THE ABOVE-REFERENCED PROJECT, AND CONTRACT THE PROJECT IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED THE ESTIMATES, IN ACCORDANCE WITH APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2002 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS,** Council has considered general estimates for completion of the Scioto Ridge Pathway Improvement project in the amount of Thirty Five Thousand dollars (\$35,000, which includes a 10% contingency), and

**WHEREAS,** Council has determined to proceed with completion of this capital improvement project during the year 2002, and has further authorized preparation of engineer's estimates and solicitation for bids, and

**WHEREAS,** the project will be funded by the Ohio Department of Natural Resources Recreational Trails Program up to \$35,000, the Olentangy Local School District, and the City of Powell.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: The City Engineer is directed to prepare final engineer's estimates and authorized to have plans and specifications prepared for the completion of the Scioto Ridge Pathway Improvement Project in accordance with the descriptions of the project attached hereto, and to advertise for bids in a manner which the City Manager deems appropriate including an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the Municipality for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks.

Section 2: The City Manager may reject any and all bids or accept a bid with the lowest responsible responsive bidder or bidders and contract with the bidder or bidders.

Section 3: The City Manager may not accept a bid in excess of ten percent (10%) of the City Engineer's estimate and the authorization for expenditure of funds contained herein shall not exceed the use of Thirty Eight Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$38,500).

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That Council declares this to be an emergency measure immediately necessary to finish this project prior to the beginning of the 2002-03 school year. Wherefore, this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
