

Ordinance No. RESOLUTION 2002-17 Passed September 3, YEAR 2002

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DELAWARE COUNTY ENGINEER TO CONTINUE INSPECTION OF SOME PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS IN THE NEWLY ANNEXED GOLF VILLAGE AREA.

WHEREAS, the area generally known as "Golf Village" has recently been annexed to the city of Powell by Ordinance Number 2002-30, and

WHEREAS, some public improvements had been underway and subject of or to inspection by the Delaware County Engineer in the area affected and

WHEREAS, Council desires to allow the County to continue inspections for those improvements already underway.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Council herewith authorizes the County Engineer to continue with inspections of public improvements for those areas under construction prior to the date of annexation, August 6, 2002.

Section 2: That the City Public Service Director shall advise the County Engineer to provide documentation relative to all inspections, punch lists and approvals to the Public Service Director.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.
