

Resolution 2002-23 Passed October 15, 2002

**A Resolution Approving a Collective Bargaining Agreement for the City of Powell and AFSCME, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO**

**Whereas**, Ohio Revised Code Section 4117.04 requires a public employer to bargain collectively with an exclusive representative of employees, and

**Whereas**, AFSCME, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO is the exclusive representative of certain employees in the City of Powell Public Services Department, and

**Whereas**, pursuant to the provisions of Ohio Revised Code Chapter 4117, the City of Powell and AFSCME, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO met for the purpose of collective bargaining, and

**Whereas**, the City of Powell and AFSCME, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO have reached agreement for a collective bargaining agreement regarding certain employees of the Public Services Department, and

**Whereas**, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 4117.10(B) the agreement must be presented to the legislative authority so that it may approve or reject the submission of the agreement as a whole.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That we do hereby approve and authorize the entering into a collective bargaining agreement between the City of Powell and the American Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees, Ohio Council 8, AFL-CIO for certain employees of the Public Services Department. Said agreement to be effective October \_\_\_\_, 2002 through October \_\_\_\_, 2005.

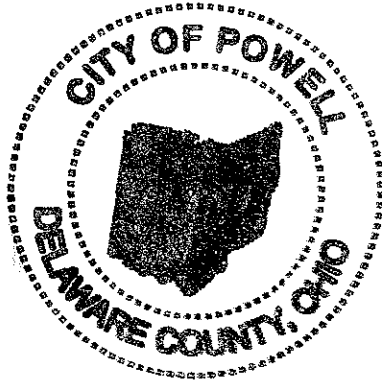
