**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL EMERGENCY MUTUAL AID AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS,** State of Ohio law authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide services, and

**WHEREAS,** State of Ohio law and state policy also provides for certain reimbursements or financial aid to local government for certain disasters and emergency conditions declared by the Governor, and

**WHEREAS,** the Cities, Villages, and Townships, that are signatories to this agreement, finds it to be their best interest to have such mutual aid agreements with other local governmental bodies in the state and region, and

**WHEREAS,** Council has determined that it is beneficial for the City of Powell to participate in such a mutual aid agreement.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the Council of the Municipality of Powell hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an Intergovernmental Emergency Mutual Aid Agreement, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.
