A RESOLUTION DESIGNATING NOVEMBER 8 AS COMMUNITY AND REGIONAL PLANNING DAY

WHEREAS, November 8th of each year has been celebrated as World Town Planning Day in many countries since its inception in 1949, and

WHEREAS, the American Institute of Certified Planners (AICP) acting for the 14,000 members of the planning profession in America, the professional institute of the 33,000 member American Planning Association, endorses World Town Planning Day as an opportunity to highlight the contributions sound planning makes to the quality of our settlements and environment and to celebrate American accomplishments in making collective decisions concerning our cities and regions that bring quality and meaning to our lives, and

WHEREAS, the celebration of World Town Planning Day gives us the opportunity to publicly recognize the participation and dedication of the members of planning commissions and other citizen planners who have contributed their time and expertise to the environment of the city of Powell, and

WHEREAS, we recognize the many valuable contributions made by professional community and regional planners of the City of Powell and extend our heartfelt thanks for the continued commitment to public service,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That November 8 is hereby designated as Community and Regional Planning Day in the city of Powell in conjunction with the worldwide celebration of World Town Planning Day.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 4: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

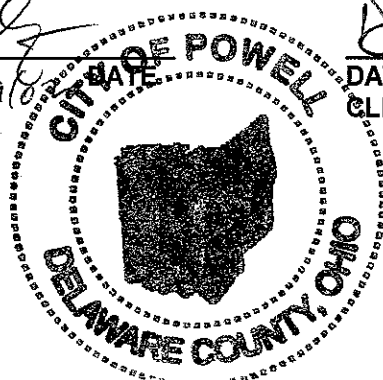


