AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PARK SITE MASTER PLANS.

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a Master Plan for Arbor Ridge, Beechwood, Library, Meadow View, Memorial, Murphy's, Black Oak, Powell Place, and Village Green Parks.

WHEREAS, City Council has determined it is desirable to adopt these plans in order to move forward with park development and to repeal previously-adopted plans for such parks within the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the Municipality of Powell hereby adopts the Master Plan for the park sites which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That the Council of the Municipality of Powell intends to begin engineering and designing these parks utilizing a process which will permit the public to review and provide comments in regard to the proposed construction documents.

Section 3: That Ordinance 99-07 approving the East Park Master Plan (Arbor Ridge) and Ordinance 2000-11 adopting the Ashmoore Park Site Master Plan (Meadow View) are hereby repealed.

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
