

RECORD OF ORDINANCES

Ordinance No. 19

Passed August 8th, 1949.

- Sec. 6. CONSTRUCTION BY PRIVATE OWNER: Construction of a Street Sidewalk may be made by a private owner at his or her expense, so long as he or she complies strictly with this ordinance, but first he or she must obtain a permit (Without cost) for such construction from the Street Commissioner who will inspect the work during construction, and if all requirements are complied with he will sign and O. K. same upon completion. Otherwise construction of Street Sidewalks without a permit shall constitute a mis-demeanor and shall be subject to the penalties of this ordinance.
- Sec. 7. The Village may stand a part of the expense of constructing Street Sidewalks up to One-half ($\frac{1}{2}$) of the expense in-so-far as funds are available for this purpose, and a copy of all itemized bills by the vendor or vendors are presented to the Street Commissioner and O. K'd. by the Finance Committee of the Village.
- Sec. 8. PENALTIES: Any person violating all or any part of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a mis-demeanor and shall be fined not less than Fifty (\$50.00) dollars nor more than Two-hundred (\$200.00) dollars and costs of prosecution for each and every offense of this ordinance.
- Sec. 9. This Ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, safety, general welfare and development of the Village of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio, and shall go into effect immediately upon its passage by Council and as such time has elapsed as is required by law.
