

Ordinance 2003-40

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH KINZELMAN KLINE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING PROFESSIONAL PLANNING SERVICES TO PREPARE A DOWNTOWN REVITALIZATION PLAN AS PART OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN UPDATE.**

**WHEREAS,** the City is in the process of updating its Comprehensive Plan, and

**WHEREAS,** the City has received proposals from companies to perform planning services, and

**WHEREAS,** a special committee has recommended the firm Kinzelman Kline to perform planning services to create a Downtown Revitalization Plan.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with Kinzelman Kline on behalf of the Municipality for the purpose of performing professional planning services pursuant to a contract as attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

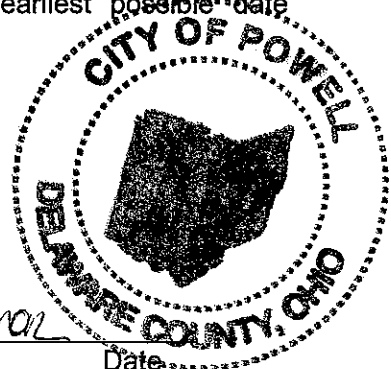
Section 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to pay Kinzelman Kline the sum not to exceed Forty Five Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$45,500) for cost of services rendered pursuant to the terms of the executed contract.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.
