

**RESOLUTION 2003-07  
PASSED FEBRUARY 18, 2003**

**A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF LIBERTY TOWNSHIP'S EFFORT IN CREATING AN EAST-WEST MAJOR COLLECTOR ROAD BETWEEN STATE ROUTE 315 AND LIBERTY ROAD SOMEWHERE BETWEEN RUTHERFORD ROAD AND HOME ROAD**

**WHEREAS**, the Liberty Township Comprehensive Plan states on page 16, that the addition of a major collector road between State Route 315 and Liberty Road, preferably to connect with either Rutherford Road or Seldom Seen Road, is one part of the overall concept of development in Liberty Township through the year 2010, and

**WHEREAS**, the connection of this connector is no longer feasible to the intersection of Liberty Road at Seldom Seen Road or at Rutherford Road due to developments which have occurred that did not allow for the connector to be located there, and

**WHEREAS**, the last chance to implement a connector that will help to relieve increasing traffic burdens on other east/west roads in southern Liberty Township such as Home Road, Carriage Road and Powell Road is on undeveloped land north of Rutherford Road between Liberty Road and State Route 315.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:**

Section 1: That the City Council of Powell supports Liberty Township's effort in creating an east-west Major Collector Road between State Route 315 and Liberty Road somewhere between Rutherford Road and Home Road, much like as shown on Figure 1, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, in order to relieve increasing traffic burdens on other east/west roads in southern Liberty Township as provided for within the Liberty Township Comprehensive Plan.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

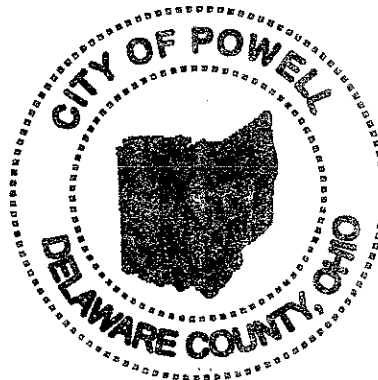
Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.
