

RESOLUTION 2003-11

A RESOLUTION ADOPTING A 5-POINT COOPERATIVE EFFORT INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, In 2002, Liberty Township and the City of Powell determined that it was in the best interest of their residents to enter into a Cooperative Economic Development Agreement which has helped to establish a long-lasting, binding relationship between the two bodies, and

WHEREAS, the Liberty Township Trustees and the City of Powell Council believe ongoing cooperative efforts are beneficial for both parties; and

WHEREAS, Liberty Township and the City of Powell support a 5-point plan in order to continue past and ongoing cooperative efforts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:


Section 1: That the Township and the City support a 5-Point plan for cooperation which includes:

- Increasing and formalizing communications between the Township Trustees and the City Council
- Coordinating community services
- Controlling development through unified, coordinated planning
- Establishing and pursuing joint recreation goals
- Integrating transportation plans


