

RESOLUTION 2003-18

A RESOLUTION TO ENTER INTO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE DELAWARE SOIL AND WATER CONSERVATION DISTRICT FOR THE PURPOSE OF CONTINUED IMPLEMENTATION OF THE CITY OF POWELL'S STORM WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN AS REQUIRED FOR COVERAGE UNDER THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY PERMIT RESULTING FROM THE NPDES, PHASE II REQUIREMENTS.

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Powell, Ohio has been designated an NPDES Phase II community by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency within its Phase II Final Rule published in the Federal Register on December 8, 1999 (64 FR 68722) and;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Powell, Ohio is covered under the State of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency's "Authorization For Small Municipal Storm Sewer Systems Located Within Rapidly Developing Watersheds To Discharge Storm Water Under That National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System" – Permit Number OHQ100000 and;

WHEREAS, the Minimum Control Measure No. 1, "Public Education/Outreach", within the Storm Water Management Plan, being part of the aforementioned permit, requires the City to enter into an intergovernmental agreement with the Delaware Soil and Water Conservation District and;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Powell, Ohio desires to comply with the NPDES Phase II storm water regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, THAT:


Section 1: The Council of the Municipality of Powell hereby supports the Storm Water Management Plan which is designed to provide a means by which the Municipality of Powell will meet the requirements of Permit Number OHQ100000.

Section 2: The Council of the Municipality of Powell authorizes the Municipal Manager to enter into an intergovernmental agreement (attached) with the Delaware Soil and Water Conservation District for the purpose of meeting certain requirements set forth in the Municipality's Storm Water Management Plan.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.
