

ORDINANCE 2004-08
Passed February 17, 2004

AN ORDINANCE FINDING EVANS, MECHWAR, HAMBLETON & TILTON, INC. QUALIFIED TO PROVIDE DESIGN ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE EXTENSION OF MURPHY PARKWAY CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Council has set forth a procedure for the solicitation of professional design services, such services generally defined as services provided within the scope of practice of an architect or landscape architect or professional engineer or surveyor, and

WHEREAS, this procedure was adopted by the City Council in Ordinance 2003-52, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the procedures established in ordinance 2003-52, the City Council has the authority to find an eligible design firm is qualified to provide services and determined to be the most qualified for a project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: Council has determined that the unique qualifications of Evans, Mechwar, Hambleton & Tilton, Inc. makes them uniquely qualified to serve as the design engineer for the city's Murphy parkway extension Capital Improvement Project.

Section 2: EMH&T was the design firm for the Murphy park subdivision (including existing Murphy Parkway), Grandshire subdivision (including existing Murphy Parkway), Lakes of Powell Subdivision (including the County's sanitary sewer force main).

Section 3: EMH&T has already worked with the City to develop the preliminary horizontal alignment of the Murphy Parkway extension.

Section 4: The City Manager or his designee is authorized to negotiate a contract with EMH&T to provide design engineering services for the extension of Murphy Parkway to South Liberty Street.

Section 5: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 6: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
