

ORDINANCE NO. 2004-20
Passed March 23, 2004

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH TEAM PAIN ENTERPRISES, INC. FOR DESIGN BUILD SERVICES FOR A SKATE PARK IN THE AMOUNT OF THREE HUNDRED SIX THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$306,000) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT.

WHEREAS, Council has previously developed a plan for improvement of the parks within the City and,

WHEREAS, Pursuant to such plan, Council determined that development of a "Skate Park" was necessary and that design of the same and construction required unique qualifications and,

WHEREAS, Council having previously determined that Team Pain Enterprises, Inc. is uniquely qualified for the construction of the "Skate Park" and Council having reviewed the proposed contract with Team Pain Enterprises, Inc. finds the same to be in the best interest of the residents of the City.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby authorizes the City Manager to enter into a certain contract for design build services with Team Pain Enterprises, Inc. for construction of a Skate Park in Memorial Park, in an amount not to exceed \$306,000 (Three Hundred Six Thousand Dollars)

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this *Ordinance* were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: This *Ordinance* shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

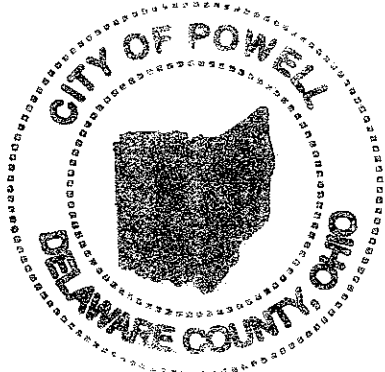
