

ORDINANCE 2004-62
Passed October 19, 2004

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING PARK RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR PARKS WITHIN THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF AND REPEALING ORDINANCE 93-15.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to update the rules and regulations for parks within the Municipality of Powell and to provide penalties for violation thereof, and

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation Advisory Board has recommended the adoption of certain rules and regulations for parks within the Municipality of Powell, and

WHEREAS, Council having determined that adoption of the attached rules and regulations for parks in the Municipality of Powell is in the best interest of the residents of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the park rules and regulations together with the penalties set forth therein which are attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference are hereby adopted, ratified and approved by the Council of the Municipality of Powell.

Section 2: That the attached park rules and regulations are adopted by the Municipality of Powell for the purpose of preserving and promoting the public health, safety and welfare of the resident of the Municipality of Powell.

Section 3: These rules and regulations shall be applicable to all lands as dedicated to the Municipality in the future for park purposes and shall automatically be subject to the provisions contained herein effective on the date of such dedication.

Section 4: The rules and regulations attached hereto may be modified by Council by a subsequently enacted ordinance.


Section 5: That Ordinance 93-15 is hereby repealed.

Section 6: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 7: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.


