

Ordinance 2005-33
Passed May 17, 2005

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH MS CONSULTANTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF PERFORMING PROFESSIONAL PLANNING SERVICES FOR THE SOUTHWEST QUADRANT (MURPHY PARKWAY/FOUR CORNERS).

WHEREAS, the City is in the process studying the extension of Murphy Parkway and the 4-Corners intersection, and

WHEREAS, the City has received proposals from companies to perform planning services, and

WHEREAS, the Development committee has recommended the firm MS Consultants to perform these planning services.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to enter into a contract with MS Consultants on behalf of the Municipality for the purpose of performing professional planning services pursuant to a contract as attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to pay MS Consultants the sum not to exceed Twenty Thousand Two Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$20,250.00) for cost of services rendered pursuant to the terms of the executed contract.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

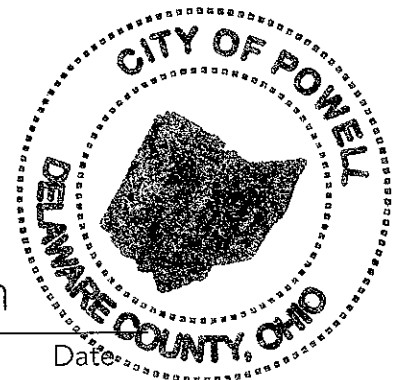


