

ORDINANCE 2005-46

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2005 in accordance with the information contained herein.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Finance Director is hereby authorized and directed to transfer \$15,000 from the Street Maintenance & Repair Fund – Snow & Ice Removal, Operating Expenses category to the Street Maintenance & Repair Fund – Street Maintenance Program, Operating Expenses category.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.
