ORDINANCE 2005-56

Passed November 1, 2005

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING SOLICITATION OF BIDS FOR REFUSE SERVICE IN THE CITY OF POWELL, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ACCEPT THE LOWEST AND BEST BID FOR SUCH SERVICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell currently contracts with Rumpke Waste, Inc., for refuse services in the City of Powell, and said contract expires on December 31, 2005, and

WHEREAS, Council desires to solicit bids for waste services within the City, and

WHEREAS, it is hereby determined that an emergency exists having a direct effect upon the health, safety, and welfare of the residents in the need to secure trash services prior to the expiration of the contract with Rumpke Waste, Inc.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: The Public Service Director is directed to prepare plans and specifications for refuse services in the City of Powell, and to advertise for bids in a manner which the City Manager deems appropriate including an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the Municipality for not less than two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks.


Section 2: The City Manager may reject any and all bids or accept a bid with the lowest responsible bidder or bidders and contract with the bidder or bidders.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.





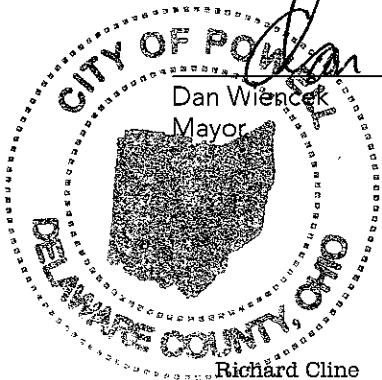
