ORDINANCE 2005-67

Passed December 6, 2005

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2005 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2005 in accordance with the information contained herein.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2005 by increasing certain accounts and decreasing others due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines an emergency exists in order to make the following adjustments:

Appropriate from the unappropriated fund balance:

- A. General Fund, Building Department in the amount of \$3,000.
- B. Golf Village Debt Service in the amount of \$11,850.
- C. Plumbing Inspection Fund in the amount of \$4,000.

Transfer:

- A. From General Fund, Building Department, Personal Services to General Fund, Building Department, Operating Expenses, in the amount of \$8,000.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.

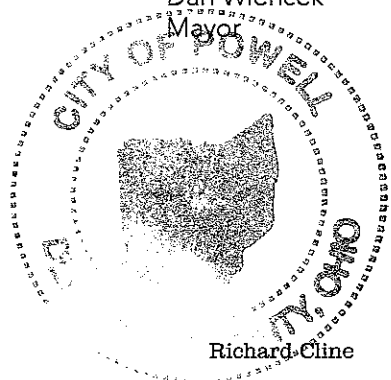


