ORDINANCE 2005-68

Passed December 6, 2005

AN ORDINANCE TO REDUCE THE 2005 GENERAL FUND BUDGET AND REAPPROPRIATE IN THE 2006 GENERAL FUND BUDGET.

WHEREAS, by Ordinance 2005-55, adopted October 18, 2005, the Council declared its intention to expand the salt bin storage facility, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2005 by reducing the General Fund, Public Service, Capital Outlay in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) so it may be completed in the next calendar year, and

WHEREAS, Council has determined it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2006 by reappropriating to the General Fund, Public Service, Capital Outlay in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby reduces the 2005 appropriation in the General Fund, Public Service, Capital Outlay in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Section 2: That Council hereby appropriates from the unappropriated balance in the General Fund, Public Service, Capital Outlay in the amount of twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000).

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

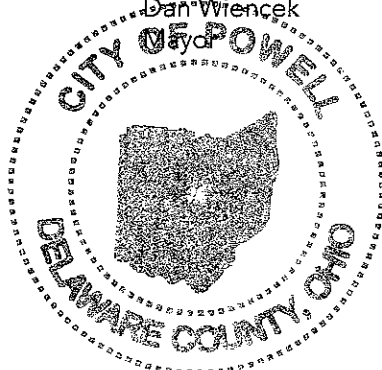
Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.
