A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CONTINUE TO EXPLORE PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP OPPORTUNITIES WITH THE OLENTANGY SWIM ASSOCIATION, INC.

Whereas, The City recognizes that competitive pressures from both public and private enterprises have placed the long term financial well being of the OSA at risk and

Whereas, The City has previously resolved to enter into negotiations with the OSA regarding assumption of the assets and liabilities of the Olentangy Swim Association (OSA), and

Whereas, The City has committed resources to providing a balanced program of recreational opportunities to it's residents. and

Whereas, The City affirms its desire that swim facilities be available to residents at a reasonable cost as part of that program, and

Whereas, The City has determined that a continued public/private partnership best meets that need, and

Whereas, The City wishes to continue to explore partnership opportunities with the OSA.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City wishes to strengthen it's existing relationship with the OSA by exploring providing financial and marketing assistance to the OSA in 2005.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.
