A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION NUMBER 2005-17 AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL OF REFERENDUM PETITIONS TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS REGARDING THE CONTENT OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 2005-13 DEALING WITH THE CREATION OF THE DOWNTOWN POWELL IMPROVEMENT INCENTIVE DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the Referendum Part Petitions circulated in accordance with the above issue are legally insufficient and,

WHEREAS, Council is charged pursuant to the terms of the Charter to determine the sufficiency of such Petitions.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

**Section 1:** Council hereby repeals Resolution Number 2005-17 for the reason that the Part Petitions circulated are legally insufficient pursuant to the terms of the Charter to submit the issue as a Referendum Petition to the voters.




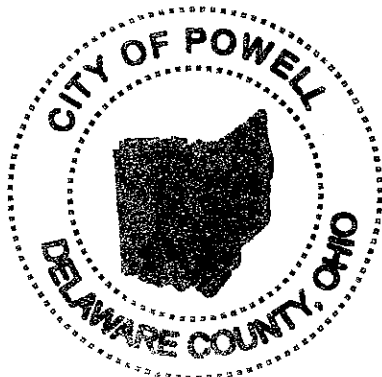
**Section 3:** This Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible day permitted by law.


