ORDINANCE 2006-29

Passed April 18, 2006

AN ORDINANCE TO GRANT FINAL ACCEPTANCE OF THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS OF CHAMBERS GLEN SUBDIVISION AS THE SAME IS NUMBERED AND DELINEATED UPON THE PLAT THEREOF RECORDED IN CABINET 2, SLIDES 82 AND 82A DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO RECORDS.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell has previously approved a plat for Chambers Glen, which has been duly recorded in the offices of the Delaware County Recorder in Cabinet 2, Slides 82 and 82A, and

WHEREAS, all major components of the public construction of the development are completed, satisfactorily maintained, all defects or deficiencies have been corrected and all expenses incurred by the City pursuant to the development have been paid in full.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That all major components of the public improvements noted upon the plat of Chambers Glen, of record in Cabinet 2, Slides 82 and 82A, Delaware County, Ohio records are hereby granted final acceptance by the Municipality of Powell.



Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

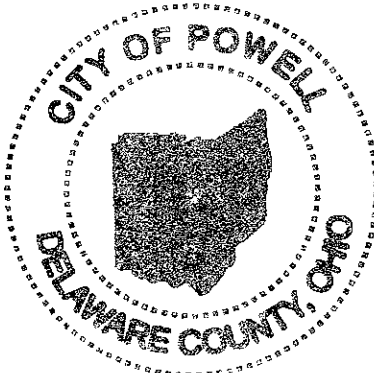


