ORDINANCE 2006-40

Adopted July 5, 2006

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A FOUR WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL PARKWAY/VINWOOD LANE/WINDWILLOW COURT AND REQUIRING THE CITY MANAGER TO PLACE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, Council has the authority to regulate traffic control devices within the Municipality of Powell and has determined that it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the Municipality of Powell to create a four way stop at the intersection of Presidential Parkway/Vinwood Lane/Windwillow Court.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That the intersection of Presidential Parkway/Vinwood Lane/Windwillow Court shall be designated as a four way intersection stop.


Section 2: That the City Manager shall have appropriate traffic control devices placed at the subject intersection at the earliest possible opportunity following the adoption of this Ordinance.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

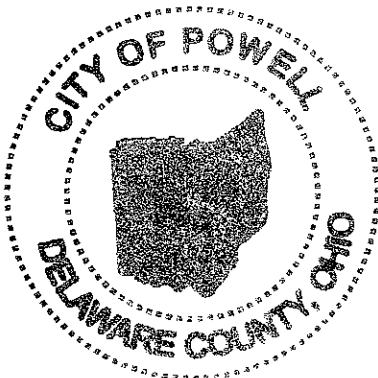
