**AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2006.**

**WHEREAS,** Council has determined that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2006 in accordance with the information contained herein.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2006 by increasing certain accounts and decreasing others due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

Appropriate from the contingency balance:


1. General Fund, Development/Downtown, Personal Services in the amount of \$4,450.00;
2. General Fund, Development/Downtown, Operating Expenditures in the amount of \$300.00;
3. General Fund, Development/Downtown, Capital Outlay in the amount of \$2,500.00.

**Section 2:** It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


**Section 3:** That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest period allowed by law.

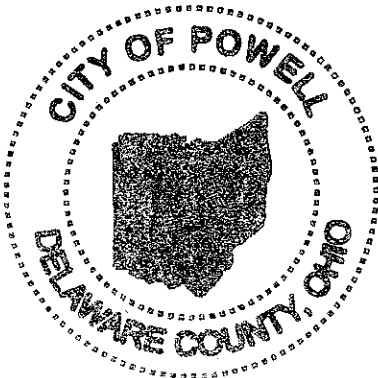


