RESOLUTION 2006-06

Passed February 21, 2006

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE OLD FIRE STATION BUILDING MAINTENANCE FUND.

WHEREAS, the Old Fire Station was acquired by the City as a part of the Liberty Township Land Swap, and

WHEREAS, revenues in the form of rental income have and will be received for this property, and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that these funds be held in a separate fund until such time as they may be utilized for building-related maintenance and the costs of renting.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there be established a special revenue fund known as the Old Fire Station Building Maintenance Fund.

Section 2: That the funding for these expenditures will be from funds to be received from rental income for the building.


Section 3: That appropriations for the fund shall be authorized by Council.

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

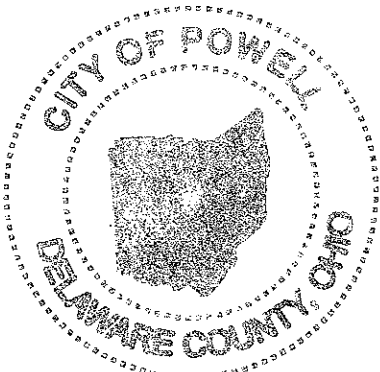
