A RESOLUTION DETERMINING THE NECESSITY TO REPAIR OR REPLACE SIDEWALKS IN THE CITY OF POWELL.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Chapter 905 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Powell, the City Engineer has conducted a survey of sidewalks, integral approaches/aprons and related areas which are in need of repair or replacement in the City and

WHEREAS, pursuant to such survey, the City Engineer has developed a list of properties requiring repair and/or replacement of such areas and

WHEREAS, notice having been provided to the owners of such properties and there having been no repairs completed by owners and

WHEREAS, Council therefore has determined that repair and/or replacement of these properties is now necessary.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Engineer is authorized to prepare a solicitation for bids including all costs and administrative costs associated with the completing of the public improvements and/or repairs as reflected on the attachment hereto which is incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

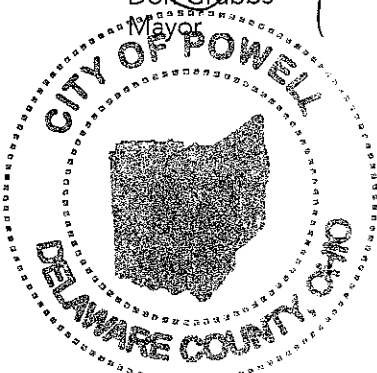


