RESOLUTION 2006-33

Adopted October 17, 2006

A RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF THE DELAWARE-MORROW MENTAL HEALTH & RECOVERY SERVICES BOARD LEVY ON THE NOVEMBER 7, 2006 BALLOT.

WHEREAS, mental illness and substance abuse issues impact the lives of children, adults and families residing in the City of Powell, and

WHEREAS, treatment is available, treatment works, and people recover from mental illness and substance abuse disorders, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware-Morrow Mental Health & Recovery Services Board is the public agency responsible for mental health and substance abuse treatment and prevention services in Delaware County, and local support is needed for this vital safety net of services, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware-Morrow Mental Health & Recovery Services Board directs ninety-four cents of every tax dollar toward direct services, and

WHEREAS, the Delaware-Morrow Mental Health & Recovery Services Board operates within the same millage first passed in 1986 and is seeking a 1 mill, 5 year replacement levy to maintain and enhance prevention and treatment services that save lives, keep kids off drugs and alcohol, keep families together, help people return to work and make our community a better place to live.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That it is hereby resolved that Powell City Council lends its public support for the passage of the Delaware-Morrow Mental Health & Recovery Services Board levy which will appear on November 7, 2006 ballot.



Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

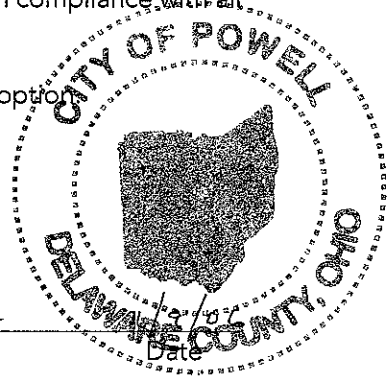


