Adopted November 9, 2006

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH THE DELAWARE, OHIO CITY PROSECUTOR'S OFFICE.

WHEREAS, State of Ohio law authorizes local governments to contract with each other to provide services, and

WHEREAS, The City of Powell currently uses the service of the Delaware City Prosecutor's office to prosecute all cases coming before the Delaware Municipal Court arising out of alleged violations of the Codified Ordinances of Powell.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is beneficial for the City of Powell to enter into an agreement with the Delaware, Ohio City Prosecutor's Office so that they may provide that service.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the Council of the Municipality of Powell hereby authorizes the City Manager to execute an agreement with the Delaware, Ohio City Prosecutor's Office, which is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the Municipality of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the Municipality of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

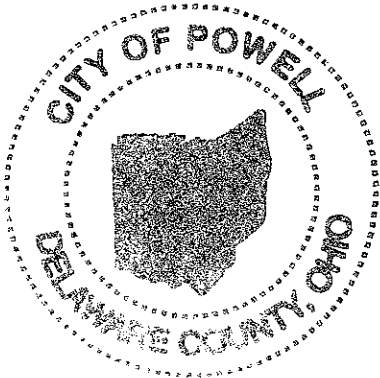
