**ORDINANCE 2007-04**

Adopted January 16, 2007

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO SOLICIT BIDS FOR THE WEST OLENTANGY STREET AND VILLAGE POINTE DRIVE PATHWAY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS,** Council has considered general estimates for completion of the West Olentangy Street and Village Pointe Pathway in the amount of Two Hundred Three Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$203,000.00), and

**WHEREAS,** Council has determined to proceed with completion of this capital improvement project during the year 2007, and has further authorized preparation of engineer's estimates and solicitation for bids, and

**WHEREAS,** it is hereby determined that an emergency exists to begin this project during the spring construction period.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1:** The City Engineer is directed to prepare final engineer's estimates and authorized to have plans and specifications prepared for the completion of the West Olentangy Street and Village Pointe Pathway in accordance with the descriptions of the project attached hereto, and to advertise for bids in a manner which the City Manager deems appropriated including an advertisement in a newspaper of general circulation in the City for not less that two (2) nor more than four (4) consecutive weeks.


**Section 2:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

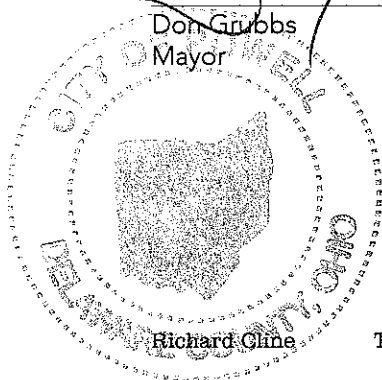
