ORDINANCE 2007-10

Adopted February 12, 2007

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO AWARD A BID TO TRUCCO CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$222,282.40 FOR THE 2007 WEST OLENTANGY STREET PATHWAY AND VILLAGE POINTE PATHWAY PROJECT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City has received bids from contractors to complete the 2007 West Olentangy Street Pathway and Village Pointe Pathway Project, and

WHEREAS, Council and Staff recommend Trucco Construction Co., Inc. as the lowest and best bidder for the above mentioned project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: The Council hereby awards the bid for the 2007 West Olentangy Street Pathway and Village Pointe Pathway Project to Trucco Construction Co., Inc. and authorizes the City Manager to enter into a contract on behalf of the City for the purpose completing the above mentioned project pursuant to the contract documents.


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to begin this project during spring construction period; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

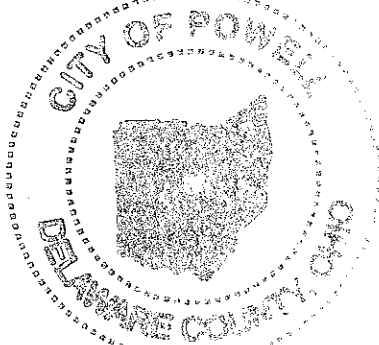
