ORDINANCE 2007-12

Adopted February 12, 2007

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING PURCHASE OF POLICE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Council has determined that it is necessary and has adopted a formal Purchasing Policy in order to provide aid to departmental personnel and the most value to City residents, and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policy requires that all specific purchases for amounts over \$25,000 must be approved by the City Council, and

WHEREAS, the purchase of office equipment for the Police Department facility will require funding in the amount of \$45,057.38.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1: That Council hereby approves the expenditure of funds in the amount of \$45,057.38 to purchase Police Department Equipment.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the City and its inhabitants for the reason that there exists an imperative necessity to enter into a purchase agreement for such equipment; wherefore, this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage.

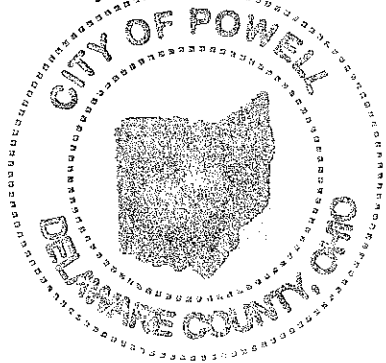
