ORDINANCE 2007-16

Adopted March 6, 2007

AN ORDINANCE DESIGNATING A THREE WAY STOP AT THE INTERSECTION OF PRESIDENTIAL PARKWAY AND DONERAIL AVENUE AND REQUIRING THE CITY ENGINEER TO PLACE TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES AT THE INTERSECTION.

WHEREAS, Council has the authority to regulate traffic control devices within the City of Powell and has determined that it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Powell to create a three way stop at the intersection of Presidential Parkway and Donerail Avenue.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the intersection of Presidential Parkway and Donerail Avenue is hereby designated as a three way stop intersection.

Section 2: That the City Engineer shall post the appropriate traffic control devices at the subject intersection.

Section 3: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.



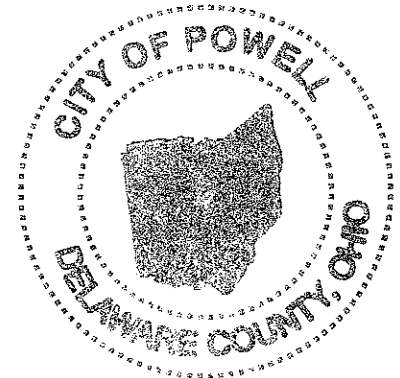
