ORDINANCE 2007-38
Adopted July 17, 2007

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ASSIST THE DELAWARE AREA TRANSIT AGENCY (DATA) WITH FUNDING NEEDS IN PROVIDING PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION TO CITY OF POWELL RESIDENTS AND POWELL AREA EMPLOYEES.

WHEREAS, the Delaware Area Transit Agency (DATA) provides public transportation within the Delaware County area including service to City of Powell residents and Powell area employees; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined that providing reasonably priced public transportation is in the best interest of its residents.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That the City Manager is hereby authorized to provide funding assistance to the Delaware Area Transit Agency in the amount of \$1090.00 for the fiscal year 2007.


Section 2: That the City manager is authorized to provide assistance to the Delaware Area Transit Agency in future fiscal years through the normal budgeting process for the City of Powell.

Section 3: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 4: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest date permitted by law.



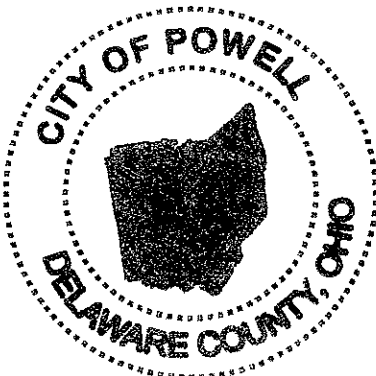
