ORDINANCE 2007-46

AN ORDINANCE MODIFYING APPROPRIATIONS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2007.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to modify appropriations for the calendar year 2007 in accordance with the information attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2007 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

Appropriate from the unappropriated fund balance:

Parks & Recreation Program Fund, Operating Expenditures, in the amount of \$15,000.00.

Transfer appropriations:


Transfer from General Fund, Downtown Promotions, Personal Services, in the amount of \$13,571.49 and General Fund, Downtown Promotions, Capital Outlay, in the amount of \$1000.00 to General Fund, Downtown Promotions, Operating Expenditures.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.

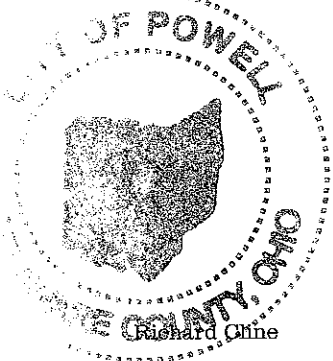


