ORDINANCE 2007-58

Adopted November 20, 2007

AN ORDINANCE ACCEPTING THE ANNEXATION OF A 9.575 ACRE TRACT, MORE OR LESS TO THE CITY OF POWELL.

WHEREAS, a Petition having been filed for annexation of a 9.575-acre tract, more or less to the City of Powell with the Board of Delaware County Commissioners, by Eugene L. Hollins, Agent/Petitioner; and

WHEREAS, proceedings having been had before the Board of Commissioners of Delaware County on August 30, 2007, wherein said Commissioners approved the annexation; and

WHEREAS, more than sixty days having elapsed from the date of filing of the transcript of such approval by the Board of Delaware County Commissioners with the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, Council has determined that the acceptance of the subject annexation is in the best interest of the residents of the City of Powell.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby accepts the annexation of the subject 9.575-acre tract, more or less, a full description of which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference.


Section 2: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 5: That this Ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date permitted by law.



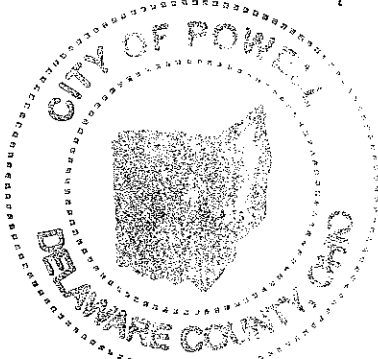
