**RESOLUTION 2007-14**

**A RESOLUTION TO ADOPT A PUBLIC RECORDS POLICY FOR THE CITY OF POWELL.**

**WHEREAS,** House Bill 9 has been adopted by the Ohio State Legislature, mandating each public body adopt a Public Records Policy; and

**WHEREAS,** House Bill 9 mandates each public body select a representative to serve as their designee and receive required training in Open Records; and

**WHEREAS,** a Public Records Policy has been drafted and recommended for adoption by the Record Commission of the City of Powell; and

**WHEREAS,** the Council has the authority to initiate such a policy.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1:** That the City Council deems it desirable to adopt a Public Records Policy attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, to provide the City of Powell with established guidelines that will ensure openness to government, while allowing efficient operation under the law.

**Section 2:** That the City Clerk shall be selected to serve as the designee of the City's elected officials regarding Public Records training programs pursuant to Section 109.43(B) of the Revised Code.


**Section 3:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

**Section 4:** That this Resolution shall take effect at the earliest possible date permitted by law.

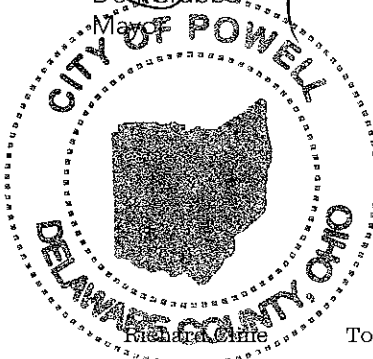


