ORDINANCE 2008-11

Adopted May 6, 2008

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO ENTER INTO A SPONSORSHIP AGREEMENT WITH THE CADBURY SCHWEPPE'S BOTTLING GROUP OF COLUMBUS.

WHEREAS, Cadbury Schwepps Bottling Group of Columbus desires to enter into a Sponsorship Agreement to sell certain of its beverage products, and the City of Powell desires to receive an annual sponsorship donation, marketing merchandise, free cases of products, and a percentage of monies collected at the City municipal building and designated Powell facilities; and

WHEREAS, the parties have negotiated a written agreement setting forth their respective rights and liabilities.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council authorizes the City Manager to enter into a Sponsorship Agreement, in a form substantially similar to the Sponsorship Agreement attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, to grant exclusive vending rights to the Cadbury Schwepps Bottling Group of Columbus with regard to certain of its beverage products and for the City of Powell to receive an annual sponsorship donation, marketing merchandise, free cases of products, a percentage of monies collected at the City municipal building and designated Powell facilities and other consideration as agreed upon by the parties in the Sponsorship Agreement.


Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

Section 3: This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest date allowed by law.

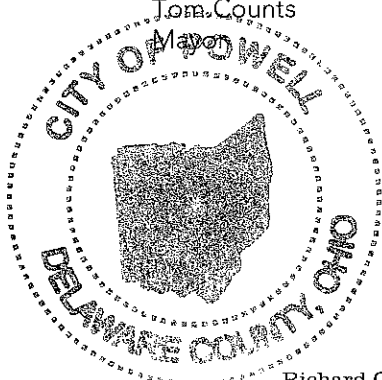


