ORDINANCE 2008-32

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING FUND TRANSFERS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2008.

WHEREAS, Council hereby determines that it is necessary to make adjustments from one fund to another for the calendar year 2008 in accordance with the information attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL CONCURRING, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2008 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

Appropriate/Transfer from the following funds:


1. Transfer from the Motor License Fund to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund in the amount of \$56,750.
2. Transfer from the FEMA Grant Fund to the Street Construction Maintenance and Repair Fund in the amount of \$20,034.00.
3. Transfer from the Old Fire Station Fund to the Capital Improvement Fund in the amount of \$5,139.00.

Section 2: It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to passage of this Ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its committees which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings so open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 3: That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.



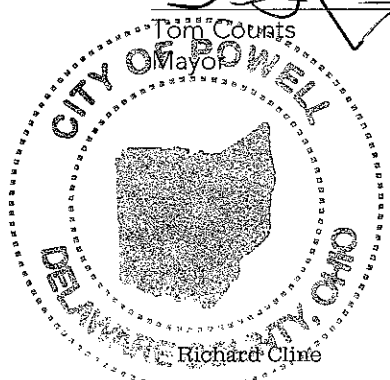
