RESOLUTION 2008-04

Adopted January 3, 2008

A RESOLUTION TO ESTABLISH THE LAW ENFORCEMENT ASSISTANCE FUND.

WHEREAS, a grant from the State Treasury's Law Enforcement Assistance Fund was applied for and received by the Powell Police Department; and

WHEREAS, revenues will be received for the funding of professional training for police officers as provided in ORC 109.803; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that these funds be held in a separate fund until such time as they may be utilized for expenses related to this grant.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: That there be established a special revenue fund known as the Law Enforcement Assistance Fund.


Section 2: That the funding for these expenditures will be from funds to be received from the awarded grant.


Section 3: That appropriations for the fund shall be authorized by Council.

Section 4: That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.


Section 5: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

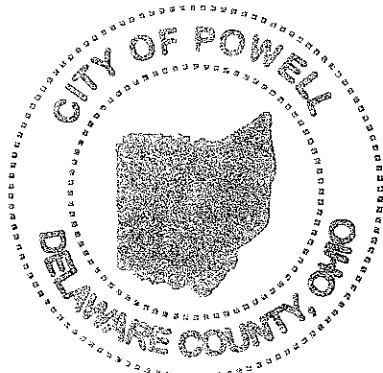
By unanimous consent, Resolution 2008-04 was adopted.
