**RESOLUTION 2008-17**

Adopted September 2, 2008

**A RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE CITY MANAGER TO DESIGNATE AREAS OF SALISBURY DRIVE AS A NO PARKING ZONE, AND AREAS OF TILLER DRIVE AS A NO PARKING ZONE ON SCHOOL DAYS FROM 3:00 – 4:00 P.M.**

**WHEREAS,** pursuant to Section 305.01 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Powell, Council has the authority to regulate traffic and parking; and

**WHEREAS,** Council has determines that sections of Salisbury Drive and Tiller Drive should be marked and designated as no parking areas;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO AS FOLLOWS:**


**Section 1:** That sections of Salisbury Drive and Tiller Drive as marked on Exhibit A, are hereby designated a "No Parking" zone.


**Section 2:** That the City Manager or his designee is authorized and directed to appropriately mark sections of Salisbury Drive and Tiller Drive as a "No Parking" zone. Such designation shall be in accordance with the Ohio Manual of Uniform Traffic Control Devices For Streets and Highways.

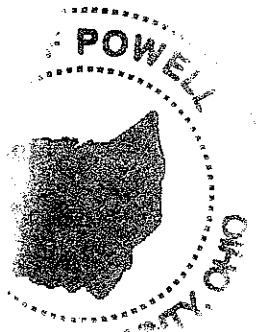
**Section 3:** That it is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of the Council and that all deliberations of the Council and any of the decision making bodies of the City of Powell which resulted in such formal actions were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements of the City of Powell, Delaware County, Ohio.

**By unanimous consent, Resolution 2008-17 was adopted.**


