A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE REJECTION OF THE FACTFINDING REPORT AND RECOMMENDATIONS IN SERB CASE NO. 08-MED-03-0245 IN THE MATTER OF FACTFINDING BETWEEN TEAMSTERS LOCAL NO. 413 AND THE CITY OF POWELL, OHIO.

WHEREAS, the City of Powell, Ohio and Teamsters Local No. 413 engaged in negotiations for a renewed contract and reached impasse regarding full contract settlement; and

WHEREAS, a Factfinding hearing was held on September 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Factfinding Report and Recommendations was issued on October 17, 2008 by the Factfinder in SERB Case No. 08-MED-03-0345; and

WHEREAS, upon review and consideration of the Factfinding Report and Recommendations, the Council of the City of Powell, Ohio moves to reject the Report and Recommendations of the Factfinder issued on October 17, 2008 in SERB Case No. 08-MED-03-0245.





Section 3: That this Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its adoption.

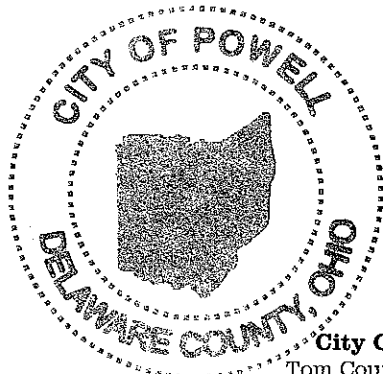


