**AN ORDINANCE APPROVING FUND TRANSFERS FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2009.**

**WHEREAS,** Council hereby determines that it is necessary to make adjustments from one fund to another for the calendar year 2009 in accordance with the information attached hereto as Exhibit A and incorporated herein by reference;

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF POWELL, DELAWARE COUNTY, OHIO, TWO-THIRDS OF THE MEMBERS OF CITY COUNCIL CONCURRING, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section 1:** That Council hereby modifies its appropriations for the calendar year 2009 by increasing certain accounts due to adjustments that need to be made to the funds. Council hereby determines to make the following adjustments:

**Appropriate from the following funds:**


1. FEMA Grant, Transfers, in the amount of \$7,884.00.
2. FEMA Grant, Transfers, in the amount of \$2,694.46.



**Section 3:** That this Ordinance shall take effect on the earliest possible date permitted by law.



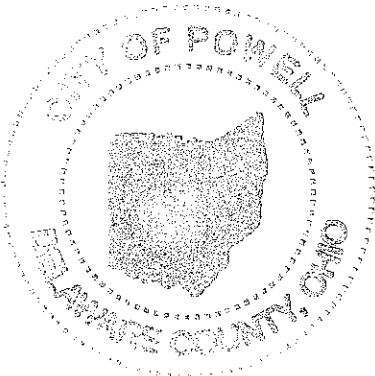
